I arrived in Viet Nam in early September 1969, a 19 year old 2LT, shortly thereafter I met the new First Sergeant (Top) Ben Weedman, he also newly arrived, on his second tour in Viet Nam, also a Korean War Veteran, at that point 23 years in the service, more years that I had spent on earth.

From the first meeting he always treating with the respect my rank required and I always treated him with the respect his experience earned him.

As I moved through the ranks from Platoon Leader to XO and a short time as CO, TOP was always there, giving me advice (behind the scenes).

I left Viet Nam and he and I parted ways, friends, comrades, never expecting to see each other again. At the 5/7 Reunion in Nashville, TN we reunited. We had not seen each other in nearly 40 years. We sat and talked, reminisced, told lies, and had a great time together. His wife and my wife are now best friends and look forward to seeing each other at reunions and visiting garden centers, while Top and I tell stories.

At another reunion I was reunited with a soldier that only spent about six weeks in the platoon before being medevac'd in January 1970, Bill Litvjak, we now speak regularly, his wife Patty and my wife do also.

This year on the way to our vacation cruise we spent the weekend with Top and Vi, better meals than on the cruise ship.

Next Reunion was attended by a soldier I met who was also newly arrived when I took over the Platoon, Dave Barnes, he and I spent the entire year together, humping the boonies, filling sand bags, pulling guard duty. Again, parted ways in August 70, did not meet again until Jacksonville reunion, we met embraced and it seemed like yesterday. His wife Wanda and my wife Mary now speak regularly, until the reunion they never met!

This is why I urge my fellow 5/7 Veterans to attend these reunions, I guarantee you will not regret it! "Now Make Your Reservations."
